## What is CSA?

CSA—short for Community Supported Agriculture—is a sales model that connects people directly with farmers.

When you sign up for a CSA membership at a farm, you pay in advance for a share of the farm’s upcoming harvest. Both you and the farmer benefit: the farmer is paid up front so gets better cash flow to put into growing the food; you get a season’s worth of fresh local food directly from the farm.
